

MILFORD HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

NOMINATION CRITERIA

- Sponsor:** Milford Athletic Boosters Club
- Mission:** To recognize athletes, coaches and contributors who have made a substantial positive impact on the athletic program at Milford High School.
- Categories:** Athlete – Must be an MHS graduate and out of high school a minimum of 5 years
Coach – Must no longer be coaching in the Milford school system
Contributor – May still be involved in the same or similar capacity
- Selection Basis:** Selections will be based on what the nominee did as a Milford High School athlete, coach or athletic contributor (may also including athletic activities, accomplishments and contributions after leaving MHS).
- Selection Committee:** A committee will be formed who is familiar with Milford High School athletic history. The “Hall of Fame Committee” and a designated chairperson will be selected by the Athletic Boosters Executive Board each year. The following should be represented, if available:
- Milford Athletic Boosters Club President
 - Current Milford Boys’ Coach
 - Current Milford Girls’ Coach
 - Community Member
 - Community Member
 - Athletic Booster Member
 - Athletic Booster Member
 - Member of Local Sports Media
 - MHS Athletic Director
- Selection Timeline:** Nominees will be submitted by the public. The following timeline will be established and followed by the chairperson or the MABC President:
- February – Posting in city and local paper outlining nomination process.
 - February through May – Committee receives nominations.
 - June – Committee meets to select Hall of Fame inductees.
 - July – The Hall of Fame Committee chairperson calls the inductees or their families as notification of selection. The chairperson then researches inductee accomplishment facts and presents the names and biographies of new inductees at the August Athletic Booster meeting.
 - September – The MHS Athletic Director and MABC President contact each inductee by letter and invite them to the induction ceremony. The chairperson secures a photograph of each inductee.
 - December – Two award plaques are ordered for each inductee. One plaque for the inductee and one to be placed in the Hall of Fame located at MHS.
 - January – Induction ceremonies will take place during pre-game of a varsity boys’ basketball contest. Inductees will be awarded a plaque and a lifetime pass to all Milford Athletic events. A dinner reception will be provided for new inductees and their families, Hall of Fame members, members of the MABC Executive Board and special guests.
