Athletic Director's Report (Aaron Zupka)

- Milford has been selected to receive a prototype of new outdoor HUDL camera system
 - Would require ethernet cable to be installed from football locker room to the press box (Milford would incur the expense for this)
 - Waiting for additional details
- Planning meeting held for new athletic facilities
 - o Architecture firm has been hired, but no budget or timeline has been determined
 - Will include the demolition of Robbins Building, football weight room, and stadium entrance with construction of new facilities to replace those areas
- Hope to replace stadium lights and install new bleachers on current Visitor side before start of 2021 fall season
 - This will increase capacity to 6500 seats
 - Once completed, Home/Visitor bleachers will be switched so that Home side is closest to concession stand
- Jeff Johnson (Operations Department) provided a new amplifier for the speaker system in the stadium

New Business

- Laura has been asked to compile list of assets owned by MABC
 - o General assets include: (2) laptops, golf cart, walkie talkie set
 - o Concessions assets (football, basketball, baseball, soccer) include the following:
 - Food machines in all concession stands (popcorn machines, hotdog rollers, pretzel machines, coffee machines, etc.)
 - > Ice machines in all concession stands
 - > Grills and tents in all concession stands
 - Rolling shelves in all concession stands
 - > Individual refrigerators/freezers in all concession stands
 - > Items in shed (football stadium)
