Craft Show (Justin Bonnell)

- Admissions = \$7151
- Same day renewals = \$15,000
- \$500 donation from Nothing Bundt Cakes
- Concessions = \$7195 (still need to remove expenses)
- Total one day = \$29,966
- Crafters did well and were very happy with sales
- Ralph Vilardo (Fire Department) is making us eliminate some spots at 2 different locations
 - Leading out of Café into Bauer Commons (hallway to the right)
 - Back hallway past small gym entrance, all the way down hall to the murals
- Looking at revamping the size of booths in small gym
- No extension cords across hallways at all
- No strollers at all (we must enforce this at entrance doors)
- Need to walk the grounds to see exactly what needs to be roped off next year
- Need to get step stools for shuttle vans
- Need to get signage/magnets for shuttle vans

Athletic Director's Report (Aaron Zupka)

- Winter sports are in full swing
- ECC Cheer at Milford on 1/29
- Will order HOF gifts/plaques

New Business

- Commercial freezer needed in basketball concession
 - Original estimate that MABC approved was \$1800 (that price is no longer available)
 - New estimate is no more than \$2200
 - MABC unanimously approved new estimate
- Current MABC accountant is going into semi-retirement, so we can either keep our current accountant or stay with current firm and get new person assigned to our account
- Baseball & softball backstop nettings are ripped and need replacement
 - Quotes from Borgeman (includes installation) are \$7500 for baseball, \$4500 for softball, plus additional \$3800 for softball batting cage
 - Fund the Flock is working to raise some money for the nets
 - Baseball and softball programs can each contribute \$2K (total of \$4K)
 - MABC can contribute between \$3500-\$5000, if needed
 - Looking at only purchasing backstop netting (no batting cage)
- Nicole Kittrell will coordinate an alumni soccer game when turf at Charity Lucas is complete
- Executive Board met and proposed changes to MOU relating to amounts and dates
