Athletic Director's Report (Aaron Zupka)

- Winter sports are ending and getting ready for spring sports
- We had 5 swimmers, and 5 indoor track/field athletes qualify for state
- Ended winter season still in 1st place for ECC All Sport Trophy
- Stadium scoreboard proposal from Scorevision
 - Milford would pay for the install cost and upkeep, and Scorevision would pay for the board itself
 - Once paid off, we would get a % of the income generated from ads
 - Waiting on final costs and dimensions (likely between \$20K-\$30K for installation)
 - Would not be ready for this fall (maybe by next spring)
 - Basketball has same board and made \$24K this year
 - Scorevision is responsible for getting the advertisers/business they are protected vendors that will take spots due to partnerships
 - Would include both videoboard and a hard board for non-school use (youth, etc.)
 - There are different packages available for video/hard boards

New Business

- Youth Football would like to propose different arrangements
 - Penni will create a contract and present to Youth Football with specifics spelled out if not agreed upon and signed by both parties, then Youth Football will not be allowed to use our facilities/supplies
- MABC Scholarships
