Treasurer's Report – Laura Dominique/Darragh Naylor

- Transferred everything to Darragh on 8/5

- \$150K in Capital fund
- \$2600 revenue from season passes so far

- Voted to move \$100K from General fund to Capital fund

Hall of Fame

Eagle Flight Night (Todd Moore)

- Todd is working on banner right now
- All previous year's framed Flight Night posters will be moved from current location in Fley Center
- Need to encourage more coach involvement to promote events to their players

Athletic Director's Report (Aaron Zupka)

- Aaron Zupka introduced himself as the new HS Athletic Director
- Introduced Clay Perry as one of his interns/assistants
- There was a large carryover from past several years that was spent at the end of the school year, so AD budget will be pretty tight this year
- Aaron requested that we vote to either upgrade (from stationary to mobile) or replace the existing scorer's tables to allow for increased safety and traffic flow in the main gym
 - Currently have (2) 8 ft. tables that are owned by Side Effects (stationary and attached to bleachers)
 - Option 1 includes: upgrading current tables (rebranding/reupholstering) and adding wheels = \$2,535
 - Option 2 includes: upgrading current tables (rebranding/reupholstering), adding wheels, and obtaining a 3rd table to match the other two = \$5,827
 - Voted to add wheels to the existing (2) tables to make them mobile, but no rebranding/reupholstering, not to exceed \$1,500
 - Motion by Laura Dominique, with 2nd by Julie Klenk
 - APPROVED
- Clarification needed from the District re: what is their role vs. what is Boosters role in funding projects
- Aaron will be holding a meeting for all HS coaches in the next week or two
- Student Athlete Recruiting Seminar will be held on 11/14 at 7:00 pm
