- Penni is making large sign with opening/closing instructions to be permanently hung (up high) in both the basketball and football concession stands
- New refrigerator in basketball is working well
- Penni removed the microwave from basketball concessions, which should alleviate overloaded breakers

Craft Show (Justin Bonnell)

- Speeches are complete
- Total expense dinner is approximately \$2,300 (90 people RSVP'd)
- Nothing Bundt Cakes has agreed to give us 30% off desserts (ordered 12 dozen bundtinis)
- Food delivered by Lehr's (appetizers at 4:30 pm, dinner at 5:00 pm)
- Need to gather contact information from all current/past inductees and put in Google doc

Flight Night (Todd Moore)

- Sold 306 tickets to date
- Marty has signed all of the baseballs and cubes have been ordered
- Oasis is allowing us to set up the night before event (3/4) beginning at 5:00 pm
- Todd is working to get more sponsor tables, as some sponsors are not returning this year
- Reds Hall of Fame is donating 2 tickets to Marty's induction this spring
- Intro speakers will be Rick Walls from Reds Hall of Fame, followed by Amanda Brenneman
- Todd continuing to get donations and raffle items

Athletic Director's Report (Aaron Zupka)

- The Flock student section has been named a finalist for the OHSAA Golden Megaphone award and will go to Columbus in mid to late March to compete for the title
- Details for HoF being finalized this week
- Signing day today - 10 student athletes signed to play their sport at the next level
- MHS signed a new contract with Pro Force, in conjunction with Cincy Sports Nation, for strength and conditioning training (contract is for 5 years, with 90 day opt out option for either side)
 - We will have a total of 7 strength coaches available to work with our athletes
 - Milford athletes can use the Pro Force weight room onsite at Cincy Sports Nation, as well as the indoor turf fields

Old Business

- Final design graphics for turf have been received and we are ready to start collecting final bids
 - Requesting bids from 3 companies – emails to be sent this week
 - Final bids due by Friday, 2/21
 - MABC to meet week of 2/24 to select contract
 - Still need to get confirmation from BoE that our revenue streams will not be altered during the life of the loan (resolution on file)
 - Laura will send letter to Aaron outlining what we need from BoE to confirm our revenue streams

New Business

- Wrestling requested help in paying for a new tripod and scale – they are working to get quotes and will pass them on as soon as they are available
- The windscreen on the girls varsity softball field has reached the end of its useful life and needs to be replaced
 - Received two quotes for new windscreen: \$3,900 and \$5,500
 - Motion made by Todd Moore to provide \$2,000 toward the purchase of a new windscreen, 2nd provided by Justin Bonnel, approved by Board
- Pat Bonnell, who was instrumental in coordinating and running the MABC Craft Show since its inception many years ago, has passed away with no life insurance
 - A Go Fund Me account has been established to collect money to help pay for funeral/burial costs
 - In order to assist the family, a motion was unanimously approved by the Board to pay the balance of Pat's funeral expenses once the Go Fund Me account has closed (not to exceed \$5,000)
