The Eagles used a strong second half to cruise past Fairfield in the playoff opener, while the Comets earned a shutout of ECC foe Lebanon to set-up this regional quarterfinal contest. Milford will count on star RB Nathan Webster to lead its offense against a tough Comet defense. The Eagle D will look to continue its second half surge that has seen them allow just 50 points over the last six and a half games, including a trio of shutouts.

Notable 2023 Performances Week 1

- Newcomer Nathan Webster made an immediate impact in his Milford debut in Week 1 vs. Edgewood. The senior transfer from the Atlanta-area and younger brother of former Eagle RB Natwan Webster rushed for 103 yards and three touchdowns in his debut.
- Senior Max Hardoerfer had the biggest play of his Milford career late in the Edgewood contest as he scooped up a fumble forced by Daniel Walker and rumbled 72 yards for a touchdown.

Week 2

- Senior Reece Davis was a dual threat in a big way in Milford's wild win over Lebanon. He opened the game with an 87-yard punt return for a touchdown, then hauled in a receiving TD late in the first quarter. He capped the night with the game-winning TD reception with 34 seconds remaining. Reece finished the night with nine catches for 130 yards, along with 175 yards in returns.
- In just his second start at QB, junior Luke Brand had a big night at Lebanon, connecting on three TD passes. He finished the night 20 of 37 for 240 yards passing.
- Junior LB Christian Felix made his first big impact play of the season on defense against Lebanon with a sack/forced fumble that set up an Eagles' touchdown. He finished with three tackles on top of the strip sack.

Week 3

- Luke Brand had a record-setting performance in the Eagles' big win over rival Loveland. For the night, Brand set a Milford school record with 423 passing yards, connecting on 34-of-46 passes and a pair of touchdowns. He also added a pair of rushing touchdowns.
- Senior K Mason Cooper connected on all seven of his extra point attempts, as well as his first career field goal, a 31-yard try against Loveland. He also kicked off a total of eight times with four resulting in touchbacks.
- Reeve Davis topped 100 yards receiving for the second straight game against Loveland, hauling in 10 passes for a career-high 172 yards.
- Nathan Webster continued to make his presence felt in the Loveland win, totaling 127 yards for his second 100-yard plus game of the year.

Week 4

 In a big win over Anderson and its high-powered offense, the foursome of Andrew Littrell, Tofa Luani, Cole Miller and Nathan Webster all played starring roles. The Eagles' linebacker threesome of Littrell (17), Miller (17) and Luani (14) combined for 48 tackles on the night as the Milford defense withstood 108 offensive snaps by Anderson. Littrell also had a sack and forced a pick-six interception return with a fierce rush of the quarterback. Luani tagged on 1.5 tackles for loss, blocked a punt, and scored three rushing touchdowns on offense. Webster matched Luani with three rushing scores, while finishing with 170 yards on the ground.

Week 5

Two under the radar seniors and Milford's rapidly improving junior quarterback played key pieces in helping the Eagles improve to 5-0 with a win over Kings. Pressed into service as the main running back, Ashton Warther finished with 172 all-purpose yards, made up of 86 rushing, 61 receiving, and 25 in kick return yards. He also scored his first TD of the season. Senior WR J.P. Naylor was QB Luke Brand's favorite target on the night, catching eight passes for 133 yards and a pair of touchdowns. Brand was phenomenal under center once again for the Eagles, completing 22-of-28 passes for 356 yards and two touchdowns.

Week 6

• A pair of seniors came up with key performances in helping Milford improve to 6-0 with a win over Little Miami. Robby Mickler came up with a pair of interceptions from his safety position and was part of a defensive effort which allowed a then season-low 219 yards and recorded its first shutout since last season's playoff opener. Nathan Webster topped 100 yards rushing for the third time in the five games he's played this season, finishing with 142 against the Panthers. He also scored three rushing touchdowns.

Week 7

 QB Luke Brand and junior WR Ethan Melgard, both played key roles in Milford's Homecoming win over Walnut Hills. Brand was outstanding once again, completing an efficient 14-of-19 passes for 224 yards and three touchdowns, while also adding a rushing touchdown. Melgard finished with a career-best 70 receiving yards on three catches, including a 33-yard touchdown.

Week 8

Milford's huge ECC win over Winton Woods had many key performances, but those by Mason Cooper, Tofa and Toto Luani, and Nathan Webster rose to the top. In a pressure-packed situation, Cooper connected on the only points of the night, a game-winning 22-yard field goal with just over two minutes to play. Tofa Luani, had 1.5 sacks, including a forced fumble on a strip, along with eight total tackles and a quarterback hurry. Toto Luani, a senior DB, led all Milford players with 10 tackles, including 1.5 for loss. Webster grinded out 98 yards on 22 carries against the ECC's top-ranked defense, the most by an opposing back against Winton Woods this season.





Week 9

• Three key seniors were impact performers in helping Milford improve to 9-0 with a win over West Clermont. LB Tofa Luani led a defense that posted its third shutout in the last four games with a game-high 10 tackles, including three for loss. Two of the three TFL were sacks. RB Ashton Warther provided 88 yards from scrimmage on 18 touches. He rushed for 50 yards on nine carries and added 38 yards receiving on nine receptions. RB Nathan Webster picked up his fifth 100-yard game of the year, finishing with 141. He also scored three touchdowns for the fourth time this season.

Week 10

- Junior super sub Caden Bailey made the most of his first career start at quarterback, connecting on 18-of-29 passes for 239 yards and four touchdowns. He's played extensively as a wide receiver this season entering week 10. Senior linebacker Andrew Littrell had a big Senior Night, finishing with 14 tackles, including 11 in the first half. It marks his third game this season with 10+ tackles. Senior JP Naylor contributed in all three phases of the game to help the Eagles secure a perfect regular season. As a fillin starter on defense, he contributed five tackles, including one for loss. He delivered seven on-target snaps as the Eagles' long snapper and logged several plays on offense at wide receiver.
- Slightly overlooked in the night of so much history being made, Eagle head coach Tom Grippa walked away with the 225th win of his long coaching career and his 50th since taking over the Milford program in 2017.

Playoffs Week 1

- Nathan Webster vaulted himself up on a pair of Milford season leader lists against Fairfield. His 1,231 yards rank second in school history. His 19 rushing touchdowns are tied for fourth. Webster also becomes the Eagles' first 1,000 yard rusher since Cameron Kells (1,607 yards) in 2018.
- The 333 rushing yards against Fairfield were the most since a 456-yard explosion against Loveland two years ago. That night was also the last time that two Milford runners went over 100 yards in the same game. That night the honors belonged to Natwan Webster and Tofa Luani. Against Fairfield, Webster rushed for 215 yards and Ashton Warther added 111.
- Finally, Webster becomes the first Milford back to crack 200 yards since Cameron Kells went for 206 against Kings in 2018.

Week 1 Game Summary

Newcomer Nathan Webster rushed for 103 yards and three touchdowns in his first game as an Eagle, leading Milford to a convincing 42-7 win at Edgewood in Week 1 of the 2023 OHSAA football season. The Milford defense was up for the task as well, holding the Cougars scoreless until early in the fourth quarter for the hosts only points of the night.

In addition to Webster's heroics, the Eagles got a solid first start at QB from junior Luke Brand who connected on 13 of 20 passes for 179 yards and a touchdown to JP Naylor. A balanced offensive attack saw the Eagles rush for 144 yards on top of the 179 through the air for 323 total. The stingy Eagle D yielded 278 total yards to Edgewood.

The Eagles put up three first half touchdowns to race to a 21-0 lead at the break. Webster hit paydirt from two yards out in the first quarter, with Tofa Luani plowing in from a yard out for the first score of the second quarter. The Brand to Naylor strike of 22 yards just seconds before the half led to Eagle three-score advantage at the break.

Webster found the end zone again in the third, this time from six yards out, with the lone Edgewood score coming at the 10:10 mark of the fourth. Webster made it three scores for the game with just under five minutes remaining, this time from 10 yards out. The punctuation on the night came in the final 2:30 when senior Max Hardoerfer scooped a Cougar fumble and raced 70 yards the other way for the final points of the night. Week 2 Game Summary

Another year, another epic, last minute battle between Milford and Lebanon. For the third time in four meetings as members of the Eastern Cincinnati Conference, the Eagles and Warriors battled until the waning seconds. This time, Milford's Reece Davis scored the game-winner with 34 seconds left to secure the Eagles' dramatic 34-29 win during Week 2 of the 2023 season.

It appeared Milford would be in position for a comfortable victory as a Luke Brand to Ethan Melgard TD toss early in the third quarter pushed the visitors in front by a 28-3 cushion. But Lebanon countered with a pair of quick scores; first on a short TD throw and less than a minute later on a perfectly executed halfback pass following a recovered onside kick. Lebanon scored twice more in the fourth quarter, the final on a 70-yard bomb to take a 29-28 lead with just four minutes to go.

The Eagles wouldn't stay down as Brand engineered a methodical, but quick drive downfield to score the go-ahead TD. Covering 11 plays and 69 yards over 1:44 and featuring several quick and short completions, the winning drive was capped by a Brand to Davis 14-yard strike. DB Tim Dick sealed the triumph with an interception on the first play of the Lebanon's last-ditch drive.

But the night belonged to Davis, as he finished with 130 yards receiving and another 175 in return yardage. He ignited the Milford crowd early, taking a punt 89 yards to the house for his second career return TD and first on a punt. Davis connected with Brand later in the first quarter for his first of two receiving scores on the night.

Nathan Webster paced the Eagle ground game with 71 hardearned yards on 20 carries, with Tofa Luani finding paydirt on a short TD out of Milford's heavy offensive set. Brand connected on 20 of 37 throws for 240 yards and the three TDs. Robby Mickler paced the defense with 10 tackles, with Will Reid joining Dick in the Eagle interception club for the night. Junior Christian Felix made his first impact play of the season in the second with a quarterback sack and forced fumble that set up an Eagle TD.

Milford is back at it next week with the final of three straight road games to open the season, travelling to rival Loveland.

Week 3 Game Summary

Junior QB Luke Brand threw for 423 yards and accounted for four total touchdowns leading Milford to a wild 52-34 win over rival Loveland on Friday night. The 423 yards by Brand is believed to be a school record, topping the highest recorded total of 387 by Hunter Johnson in 2019. The Eagle signal caller rushed for a pair of short touchdowns, while hooking up with Reece Davis and JP Naylor for his two passing scores.

Davis had another big night, catching 10 Brand tosses for 172 yards and adding 81 yards on kick returns. Nathan Webster topped the 100-yard mark for the second time as an Eagle, rumbling for 127 yards and two touchdowns. All told, Milford ran up 572 yards of total offense, the most since a 615-yard output, also against Loveland in 2019.

The fireworks started early as Loveland connected on a double pass on the first snap of the game for a 69-yard gain to set up its first touchdown. Brand's first rushing score tied the game, but on Milford's next possession, a Brand interception was returned to the Eagle one setting up another short Loveland score.

Brand retied the game later in the first with his second rushing score and the Eagles capped the first quarter scoring with a Mason Cooper 31-yard field goal to make it 17-14.

The Eagles kept pouring it on in the second quarter, first on a Brand to Davis 37-yard TD pass. A Toto Luani interception on the next Tiger possession was turned into a one-yard plunge by RB Chace Washington and a 31-14 Eagle lead. The second quarter scoring was far from complete, though as an Eagle fumble paved the way for a Loveland TD that made it 31-21. But on the last play of the half, Naylor completed a 29-yard catch and run from Brand to send the Eagles into the half up 38-21.

The second half featured trading of scores in each quarter to build to the 52-34 final. For Milford, Webster hit paydirt from 12 and four yards out, while Loveland got a Colton Endicott 37-yard jaunt and a blocked punt recovery in the end zone to round out the night's scoring.

Week 4 Game Summary

A gritty effort by the defense, a season-high in rushing offensively and a big play on special teams all played a starring role in Milford's 56-35 victory over Anderson on Friday night in the Skyline Chili Crosstown Showdown. With the win, Milford improves to 4-0 on the year and is now one of just two squads with an unblemished mark atop the Eastern Cincinnati Conference standings. It also marks the second 4-0 start in school history with the first coming last season.

The Milford D was bend but not break against the highpowered Anderson offense, withstanding an absurd 108 offensive plays by the Raptors. The Eagles recorded a pair of interceptions (one for a touchdown), four quarterback sacks and six pass break-ups in the win. Milford's linebacking trio of Cole Miller (17), Andrew Littrell (17) and Tofa Luani (14) combined for 48 tackles on the night. Luani also blocked an Anderson punt deep in its own territory to set up one of his three rushing TDs on offense.

Nathan Webster was the offensive star of the night for Milford, rumbling for a season-high 170 yards and three touchdowns. Webster's total was the most by an Eagle since his brother Natwan (182) and Luani (180) against Loveland in 2021.

The game had the expected look of a shootout from go as the first four possessions of the game resulted in touchdowns and a 14-14 score just seconds in the second quarter. Anderson struck first on its opening drive, with Webster countering with a one-yard plunge, set up by his own 58-yard run on the first Milford snap of the game. Anderson countered with a score, before Luke Brand hooked up with Reece Davis for a 54-yard bomb to even the score.

The momentum swung in the Eagles' favor next as Littrell hurried Anderson QB Justice Burnam into a pass that was intercepted by senior DL Hunter Gulaskey and returned 42 yards for a score on Gulaskey's 18th birthday. The next drive saw Milford get a defensive stop at Anderson's own 20-yard line and five plays later, Luani was in the endzone for his first score and a 28-14 Milford lead. Anderson would score again to send the teams into the half with the Eagles leading 28-21.

Milford took the second half opening kickoff straight down the field, with Luani again doing the scoring honors from three yards out. On the ensuing Anderson possession, Luani made another big play, blocking Anderson's punt attempt (just its second all season) and then plowing in from five yards out to give the Eagles a three-touchdown cushion at 42-21. The blocked punt was Milford's first since 2018 against Withrow.

Late in the third Anderson cut the deficit to 42-28 but that lasted just one play as Webster darted 45 yards for his second score of the night. Anderson scored early in the fourth quarter to get back within 14, but the Eagle D once again rose to the occasion, registering three sacks in the final quarter to seal the win. Milford's last score came courtesy of a Webster four-yard run late in the game.

The Raptors' 108 offensive snaps resulted in 553 total yards, but an average of just five yards per play. Milford churned out 200 yards rushing despite the Raptors entering the night allowing just over 91 yards per game. Brand connected on 12 of 20 passes for 176 yards, while Anderson gunslinger Burnam was 37 of 66 for 446 yards.

Week 5 Game Summary

For the first time since 1957, the Milford Eagles are 5-0 after griding out a 40-21 win at Kings in a battle of Eastern Cincinnati Conference heavyweights. The Eagles got bigtime contributions from a pair of seniors who had career nights in J.P. Naylor and Ashton Warther, along with another stellar performance from QB Luke Brand to key the win. It also marked the first Milford win over Kings since 2017.

The night started slow for both squads as the first four possessions featured three punts and a turnover on downs. Kings struck first when broken coverage allowed the Knights' Nate Lyman to break free for a 48-yard to open the nights scoring late in the first. Less than a minute into the second quarter, Tofa Luani plowed in from a yard out to tie the game on a drive aided by a pair of Kings unsportsmanlike conduct penalties and a Brand to Naylor 35-yard pass.

A fourth down trick play resulted in another Kings TD, but Warther broke loose from 17 yards out less than two minutes later for another Milford score. Kings was able to block the extra point though, leaving Milford trailing 14-13. That didn't last long however as Brand found Naylor once again, this time for a 55-yard catch-and-run TD for the senior to send the Eagles into the break up 20-14.

The only score of the third quarter came on the opening drive of the frame when on fourth and 21, Brand found Ja'Mario Sebastian for a sensational 32-yard TD reception.

Milford put the game away in the fourth quarter on the strong back of Luani who scored two more short touchdowns to give him three for the night. Carson Lindholm bulled in from one-yard out for the final Kings score in the frame as well.

Brand was phenomenal under center once again for the Eagles, completing 22 of 28 passes for 356 yards and two scores. Week 6 Game Summary

It certainly wasn't its best performance of 2023, but in the end it was enough as the Milford Eagles moved to 6-0 on the year with a 28-0 shutout victory over Little Miami. The victory, coupled with Winton Woods loss at Anderson propels the Eagles into sole possession of first place in the Eastern Cincinnati Conference standings.

Just eight days shy of one year since its last shutout, the Eagle defense was opportunistic in holding the Panthers scoreless and to just 219 yards of total offense, the least by a Milford opponent this season and the fewest since Western Hills managed just 204 in last year's OHSAA Playoff opener. Four sacks and a pair of interceptions by senior safety Robby Mickler were key elements of the defensive effort.

Milford got all the offense it would need in the first quarter, jumping to a 14-0 lead after one frame and increasing to 21-0 at the half. It looked like it would be a Milford runaway early as Nathan Webster bolted 51 yards on the Eagles' second offensive snap of the night to go up 7-0.

Mickler's first pick on the ensuing Panther drive handled the ball back to Milford at its own 33. A Luke Brand to Ashton Warther 33-yard pass was the big play of the drive which ended when Tofa Luani barreled in from three yards out. The Eagle went up 21-0 early in the second when Webster got loose and hit paydirt from 14 yards out.

Little Miami had a pair of golden scoring opportunities later in the second quarter but couldn't capitalize. First a 33-yard field goal attempt sailed wide left and later Mickler's second interception, this one at the Eagle five-yard line, turned Little Miami away once again.

Penalties plagued the Eagles, particularly in the second half as they managed just one more score late in the going. A Hunter Gulaskey sack early in the fourth set the stage for a potential scoring drive, but an Eagle fumble at the one proved otherwise. Andrew Littrell and Ashton Switzer combined for a sack to thwart the next LM drive and Webster made them pay with 34 yards on two carries, the last a three-yard jaunt for his third score of the night.

Webster finished the night with 142 yards on just 12 carries, marking his fourth time topping the century mark in his five games played. Brand was an efficient 21 of 29 passing for 220 yards, but for the first time this season did not throw a TD pass. Week 7 Game Summary

The beat rolls on for Milford and a showdown is imminent as the Eagles handled their business on Homecoming knocking off Walnut Hills by a 41-7 score to improve to 7-0 on the season. The stage is now set for one of the biggest regular season match-ups in school history as next week Milford puts its unblemished mark on the line against a Warriors squad that is 6-1 overall and 5-1 in the ECC.

Week 8 Game Summarv

At first glance, a 3-0 final score wouldn't seem overwhelming. But Milford's storybook 2023 season wrote a new chapter on Friday night as the Eagles scratched, clawed and willed their way to arguably the biggest regular season win in school history by knocking off Winton Woods. Mason Cooper's 22-yard field goal with just over two minutes remaining in the contest would be the only points, but not the end of the drama as the Warriors' nearly tied the game with under 20 seconds remaining, only to see a game-tying field goal bounce off the left upright.

Something had to give as the high-flying Eagle defense went up against the rock-solid and ECC top-ranked Winton Woods defense. But it was the Milford defense that was the story as they time and again kept the Warriors off the scoreboard. If you like defense, this was the game for you as the Eagles managed just 156 yards of total offense, but yielded only 142 on defense. If not for 55 yards gained by WW on its last drive, the number would have been even lower

Defense ruled the first half as neither team really threatened to get on the scoreboard. When the fast-moving game moved to the second half, both teams were looking for a game-changing play and there were plenty, but still no points until the final two minutes. First, Caden Bailey returned the opening kickoff 48 yards into Winton Woods territory. But one of three sacks on the night by the Warriors thwarted that drive.

Winton Woods had the next big opportunity as Zae Jennings raced 63 yards for an apparent touchdown, only to be wiped away by a holding penalty. After the teams traded punts, Milford came up with a big play on defense on the next WW possession. Deep in its own territory, Warrior QB Bryshawn Brown was strip sacked by Hunter Gulaskey with Daniel Walker jumping on the fumble at the Warrior 13-yard line.

The Eagles were able to get to the Winton Woods five-yard line and looked to go-ahead on a Cooper 22-yard field goal attempt, but a mishandled snap led to the kick sailing wide right.

Throughout 2023, senior Reece Davis has been one of Milford's most impactful players. Despite being held to just two catches for 20 yards, he made his presence felt on special teams late in the going. His 31-yard punt return put Milford in business at the Winton Woods 20 with 5:31 to play. The Eagles were able to bleed 3:30 off the clock on what would turn out to be the winning drive, capped by Cooper's game-winning 22-yard field goal with 2:07 left.

Winton Woods' final shot looked promising as pass completions of 29 and 22 yards moved the hosts to the Milford 10-yard line with less than a minute to play. But three straight incompletions, the final on a break-up by Toto Luani, set WW up for the potential game-tying field goal that bounced off the upright, sending the Eagles and their fanbase into pandemonium.

One of the big questions entering the night was would Milford be able to run against a Winton Woods defense allowing just 41.9 yards per game. Nathan Webster answered with a resounding yes as the senior grinded out 98 yards on 22 carries, the most by a Winton Woods opposing back all season. Luke Brand was held to just 13 of 21 passing for 79 yards with Ashton Warther hauling in nine passes for 53 yards.

Toto Luani led all players with 10 tackles on the night, including 1.5 for loss. Brother Tofa Luani added seven stops along with a sack.

Week 9 Game Summary

Throughout Milford's 2023 campaign, its often been the highscoring, high-flying Eagle offense that has grabbed the headlines. But over the last four-plus games, it's been the defense at the forefront and Friday night was no different as Milford shutout rival West Clermont 27-0 to improve to 9-0 on the season and clinch at least a share of the 2023 Eastern Cincinnati Conference Championship.

The shutout was Milford's third in the last four games. And the Eagles have allowed just 14 points in the last 18 quarters of play, spanning four-and-a-half games, dating back to the second half of the Kings contest. Behind 10 tackles and a pair of sacks from senior LB Tofa Luani, Milford yielded just 123 yards of total offense to the Wolves in yet another outstanding defense performance.

The offense was keyed by senior RB Nathan Webster who picked up his fifth 100-yard game of the year, finishing with 141. He also scored three touchdowns for the fourth time this season.

Milford started the night going 67 yards in 12 plays on the opening possession of the contest to go in front 6-0 on a two-yard plunge by Webster. After the defense scored a three and out, a Milford fumble deep in West Clermont territory turned away another potential scoring opportunity.

The Wolves countered with their best scoring opportunity of the evening as they moved into the Milford redzone, but a 35-yard field goal came up short against heavy pressure from the Eagles defense. As the game rolled over into the second quarter, Milford took advantage of the missed field goal, capping the drive off when QB Luke Brand went up top and found a streaking Ethan Melgard for a 43-yard TD strike less than two minutes into the second.

Turnovers and punts were the order of the balance of the second quarter with Brand getting intercepted at the goal line thwarting a solid Eagle scoring threat. The scoreboard showed a 13-0 Milford lead at the half.

To start the third, the Milford D got another quick stop, but the Eagles were pinned deep in their own end following a punt and penalty. No problem for the home team as they ran over seven minutes off the clock, going 85 yards in 19 plays to take a 20-0 lead on a one-yard rush by Webster.

West Clermont took advantage of a fourth quarter Eagle fumble to move into the redzone again, only to turn the ball over on downs with just over five minutes remaining. Looking to run off the game's remaining time, the combo of Webster and Warther did just that, with Webster putting an exclamation point on his night with a dazzling 40-yard TD run with under a minute remaining. Week 10 Game Summary

On a night with a perfect season, an outright Eastern Cincinnati Conferece title and the regional No. 1 seed all on the line, Milford delivered, doubling up Turpin 42-21 to cap the greatest regular season in the history of the school. Junior QB Caden Bailey, thrust into his first starting assignment played like a seasoned pro, connecting on four touchdown passes to push the Eagles into the playoffs on a high note. The victory secured Milford's first outright league title since 1986 and its first since sharing the 2017 ECC crown.

Bailey was dynamite from the outset, throwing three first-half TDs as the Eagles jumped to a 21-0 lead at the break. After being bottled up for much of the night, senior RB Nathan Webster came alive in the second half, finishing with 98 yards and a pair of touchdowns, to push him over the 1,000yard mark for the season; even more impressive as he played just nine regular season games.

Milford came out firing despite a steady drizzle that dropped on the Eagle Stadium Powered by Cullen Electric Field for much of the first half. On its second drive, Bailey tossed a screen to Reece Davis and the dynamic wideout did the rest, weaving through traffic for a 42-yard touchdown. After Turpin turned it over on downs on its next possession, Bailey needed just three plays to connect with Davis again, this time on 40-yard strike to push the edge out to 14-0.

With time winding down on the first half, Milford used a little trickery to go up by 21. Ashton Warther was on the receiving end of a Bailey bomb from 27 yards out following a nicely executed double reverse flea flicker.

Milford kept its foot on the gas on its first drive of the third quarter going up 28-0 on Bailey's fourth TD toss of the night, this time a 29-yarder to Jacob Luecke. It proved to be a Senior Night to remember for Luecke, Milford's three-year punter and a back-up wide receiver as his first career varsity catch went for a score.

Turpin began to come to life on its drive following the Eagles score as it marched 80 yards in 13 plays to claw within 28-7 with just over five minutes remaining in the third. The Spartans tried to make things interesting as they cut the lead to 28-14 early in the fourth on a Devan Nigam to Luke Jilek TD pass. Webster would answer, breaking loose from 20 yards out for his first score of the night.

The visitors came back again with another long drive, this time going 80 yards in 10 plays with Nigam connecting on his second TD pass of the night to again trim the Eagle lead to just 14. But as he's done so many times this season, Webster put his team on his back, gaining 40 hard-earned yards, including the final 27 for a touchdown that put the game out of reach. Will Reid put an exclamation point on the win with an interception on Turpin's final possession.

With his big 98-yard, two-touchdown night, Webster vaults himself up on a pair of Milford season leader lists. His 1,016

yards rank seventh in school history, just ahead of his older brother Natwan. His 17 rushing touchdowns are good for fifth.

Bailey completed passes to six different receivers with Warther hauling in a team-best six passes (53 yards), with Davis topping the yards category with 87. Webster hauled in four passes for 45 yards to give him a 143 from scrimmage for the night.

Andrew Littrell paced the Eagle defense with 14 tackles. The Milford D which allowed its most points since Week 5, close the regular season having allowed just 35 points in its last 22 quarters of action.

Slightly overlooked in the night of so much history being made, Eagle head coach Tom Grippa walked away with the 225th win of his long coaching career and his 50th since taking over the Milford program in 2017.

OHSAA Playoffs Opening Round Game Summary Behind a season-high 326 yards rushing, Milford overcame a slow first half to turn its OHSAA Playoffs opener into a runaway as the top-seeded Eagles routed Fairfield 41-15.

The game had the makings of a defensive standstill as the Eagles led just 7-0 at the half. But behind 215 rushing yards by Nathan Webster and another 104 from Ashton Warther, the Eagles put up 34 second half points to overwhelm the visiting Indians. The Eagles also got it done through the air as QB Caden Bailey connected on 14 of 19 passes for 155 yards and a touchdown. Webster and Warther got into the act in the passing game as well as the duo finished with 56 and 25 yards, respectively on top of their rushing exploits.

The Eagle D did its part, keeping Fairfield dual threat QB Talon Fisher in check for most of the night. Fisher, who averaged nearly 130 yards on the ground per game during the regular season, was held to just 88 on 20 carries. The performance by Milford's secondary was stellar also as Fisher completed just 9 of 26 passes for 123 yards with a pair of interceptions.

After Milford's opening drive of the night stalled out on downs, Fairfield took the ball and marched inside the Eagle 10-yard line with a 13-play, 59-yard drive. After Tim Dick broke up a Fisher pass on third down from the Eagle six, it appeared the Indians would settle for a short field goal. But the visitors had other ideas as they attempted a fake field goal. However, Fisher's pass to Tyon Spiller fell incomplete.

Fast forward to the early stages of the second quarter and Carter Ings intercepted Fisher near midfield to put the Eagles in business. Five plays later, Webster was celebrating his first touchdown of the night and 18th of the season after a three-yard run.

After forcing a punt on Fairfield's ensuing drive, the Eagles were on the move into the redzone before a wild play gave the Indians new life. Webster fumbled at the Fairfield 15, with the ball scooped up by the speedy Gabe Ross of Fairfield. He blazed down the center of the field, but an alert hustle play by Bailey saw the second fumble of the play near midfield. After the ball bounded over 20 yards down field, the Indians finally recovered at the Milford 27. It went for not however, as the Eagles forced another turnover on downs.

Webster did the lion's share of the work on Milford's first drive of the second half culminating with an 11-yard run that put the home team up 14-0. Webster keyed the next drive as well, laying out for a spectacular 40-yard reception on third down that ultimately paved the way for another stellar catch, this time by Ethan Melgard on a 14-yard TD from Bailey.

A 61-yard return on the ensuing kickoff gave Fairfield strong field position and they capitalized as Fisher found a streaking Juseters Fataki for a 33-yard TD. Webster wasted no time when Milford got the ball back, racing 64 yards down the left sideline to put the Eagles in prime scoring territory again. This time Warther carried the final 11 yards to put Milford up 28-7.

Wather produced the next big play for Milford early in the fourth quarter as he cut and sped his way 69 yards for his second rushing score of the night to make it 35-7. To Fairfield's credit, they continued to battle, clawing with 35-15 on a Fisher TD run and a two-point conversion run by Derion Prophett.

Milford wrapped things up with 2:30 to play when Tofa Luani spelled Webster and blasted in from five yards out to put the game on ice. J.P. Naylor slammed the door shut when he snagged an interception on Fairfield's final drive.

The night was full of big accomplishments, particularly in the offensive ground attack. The 326 yards gained by the Eagles were the most since a 456-yard explosion against Loveland two years ago. That night was also the last time before tonight that two Milford runners went over 100 yards in the same game. That night the honors belonged to Natwan Webster and Tofa Luani. Finally, Webster becomes the first Milford back to crack 200 yards since Cameron Kells went for 206 against Kings in 2018.

Webster also vaulted himself all the way up to second on Milford's single season rushing yards list as he sits at 1,231. Kells is the all-time leader with 1,607.
